- **Just For Fun The Dance Company** (JFF) was founded in February 1994 and was designed to meet the growing demand within the entertainment industry to provide trained performers and cheerleaders for sporting events and functions.
- In 2024 JFF celebrates 31 years as a dance company. We strive to provide each student with an
 aspiration to showcase their personal best and where desired to attain the highest standard of
 performance. Students gain confidence and experience through performing at our two Company
 concerts each year.
- JFF welcomes all ages and abilities. We run enjoyable, friendly and safe weekly classes for children from 3 years through to adults with no added pressure of competitions, examinations or extra rehearsals.
- Each class allows students to develop their skills across a range of modern dance genres. Dance styles are rotated throughout the year.
- All costumes are made for you by our specialist dressmakers with costume costs kept to a minimum.
- Our lessons are developed with a particular focus on 'having fun but still working hard'. Our students are encouraged to become technically proficient in their dance skills, building confidence & self-esteem in a non competitive environment.

Costumes

Costumes are made by JFF dressmakers and are required for our Mid Year and End of Year concerts. We endeavour to keep costume costs to a minimum. Term fees are inclusive of costume supply and cover three costumes per year. Please refer to page 8 for our 2024 fee structure.

Term Fees

Are payable at the commencement of each term. A pro-rata rate will be calculated for new students commencing after the start of a term. For term fees refer to page 8. Please note: All fees are **term fees and are non refundable.** Terms are based on school terms and vary in length from 7 to 11 weeks. Should term payments present a problem, a payment plan arrangement can be made.

Payments made after Week 3 will incur an additional fee of \$30 and extremely overdue accounts will be sent to our collection agency.

Fees are due at the commencement of each term

Students will not be permitted to commence a new term if the previous term's fees are still outstanding.

Classes

Recreational or Advanced

At **Just For Fun The Dance Company** you have options to help you decide how far or which direction you would like to take your dancing. Students can choose between taking social/recreational classes (Rainbow / Red / Yellow / Green) which are "just for fun and fitness" and include performing in our company concerts OR if you are interested in one of our advanced teams Tauri Stars, Blue Stars & Open Seniors please contact the Principal, Sue Nairn.

In 2024 advanced teams are limited to students 13 years of age and over.

Advanced Teams

TAURI STARS - 13-15 years / BLUE STARS - 15+ years / RUBU STARS - 17+ years

• Selection for advanced teams are normally made by audition or teacher recommendation late in the year (students will be advised of audition dates closer to the time)

Advanced lessons are developed to build students skills in both Dance Technique and Choreography. In technique students work across a range of styles and jazz exercises to further develop their ability in coordination, flexibility, control, balance, musicality, posture and alignment specific to technique. In choreography, dancers work with teachers developing routines that can be used in performances and competition. Our Tauri, Blue & Rubi Star students will experience the joy of performing at various regional dance competitions as well as various community events throughout the year.

Open Seniors – 18+ years

Our Open Senior (Adv) team is an adult class designed to provide students with a high level of advanced training. Dancers work with a range of choreographers offering a variety of unique movement philosophies and techniques. This class is offered as an open class to all adult students dancing at a advanced technical ability.

Advanced classes allow us to streamline dancers into appropriate ability groups providing the opportunity for students to work in a setting that best supports their interests, skills and levels.



Specialised Classes

Yoga:

A contemporary Yoga class that focuses on postures and fitness through the traditional practices of Ashtanga Vinyasa and the Iyengar Yoga methods.

Yoga seeks balance of body, mind and spirit. Asanas (movements & postures) are performed in sequences or 'flows' that allow focus on alignment, breathing, good physical health and stamina.

Run by accomplished Yoga instructor Sue Nairn. All ages, levels and abilities are welcome.



Term Fees are due at the start of each term (weeks 1-2) and must be paid prior to the end of week 3 to avoid late fees.

2024 Schedule of Fees

Fees Policy

Fees are calculated on a yearly basis and then divided into 4 equal term payments. Therefore, whether it is a long or short term, fees remain the same per term. For new students starting part way into a term, fees are calculated on a pro-rata basis. All existing students are required to pay for the full term, even if they have an extended absence.

Payment Terms

All deposits & fees are strictly payable by week 3 of Term by cash or direct deposit and are non-refundable and non-transferable. If fees remain outstanding after the payment due date (the end of week 3 of each term), an administration fee of \$30.00 will be charged per account issued.

Members unable to pay their Term fees in full by the due date should contact JFF prior to the start of term to arrange a payment plan. Unless prior arrangements have been made, continued non-payment of fees will result in students being refused entry to classes.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FAMILY DISCOUNTS WILL BE VOIDED IF FEES ARE NOT PAID ON TIME. If accounts remain outstanding, with no contact or arrangements in place, the matter will be passed on to a collection agency.

Class Information

What to wear

Neat practice clothing is required for all classes, e.g. tights/leggins or shorts, with a singlet or t-shirt. Please ensure it is something that can stretch and is easy to move in. Long hair should be tied back in a ponytail. Sneakers or bare feet are suitable for students who have just started however by their first concert performance students will need to have purchased appropriate dance footwear for the items being presented.

The regular shoe for JFF teams is **BLACK JAZZ SHOES**. These can be purchased as full sole or split sole, with laces or elasta bootie style. Dance stockists will be able to advise on which style suits your feet for optimal comfort and durability.

Weekly Lessons -

Good attendance is imperative as absences and tardiness can hold back an entire class. Catch up classes or additional lesson time is not available. Please make every effort to be at all classes and advise of any known or planned absences. Advanced classes especially require a committed attendance otherwise your place in the team will be forfeited.

Concerts -

Concert performances provide many great benefits and allow students the opportunity to showcase their work in a formal theatre setting. The thrill of performing in front of a live audience, and the experience of being backstage help students to develop an appreciation for dance as a performing art. At concerts students improve their social and communication skills, learn how to work as part of a team and grow in confidence as their work is acknowledged. The increase in students enthusiasm and energy after a concert is always noticeable. Concerts are a very special time for our students and we strongly encourage that concert dates are recorded early in the year to ensure availability. Absence at concerts effects the entire team, as such, we ask that you advise as early as possible of any issues with concert dates.

Parents and Friends Watching Weekly Classes

Parents, please be aware that your presence may be daunting to class members, so it is preferred that you leave the students alone while they take their lesson. Parents & friends may be invited at various stages throughout the term to enter the lesson and watch the last 5 minutes of class (always at the teacher's invitation).

For the comfort and wellbeing of our students we ask that phones are not used to record students work during viewing sessions - teachers are able to demonstrate choreography for recording on your request.
